## **TKO TIPS FOR USE:**

 WASH HANDS prior to use. USE ASEPTIC TECHNIQUE to minimize possible touch contamination when opening the pouch. Swab according to your protocol.



**2. THREAD COMPLETELY** or you may experience slower than normal fluid flow and/or resistance upon aspiration.

**NOTE:** If the rotating collar on the pump tubing set is not pushed all the way to the tip of the slip luer before connection, it will not be completely threaded.

**NOTE:** <u>Make sure all connections are fully threaded</u> onto the TKO prior to use or the fluid path may not be open.

**NOTE: AVOID** overtightening once fully threaded.



**3. BE SURE TO FLUSH TKO BEFORE** use to properly set the TKO diaphragm, prime all air and **AFTER** all blood draws to clear the line. Do not use a gravity set to flush the TKO.

**NOTE:** When drawing blood, especially if done too quickly, <u>you may feel a slight resistance</u> when first pulling back on the syringe plunger due to the diaphragm design. Once open for aspiration, the TKO diaphragm creates NO resistance.



4. BEFORE disconnecting syringe from TKO after a blood draw, RELEASE hand from syringe plunger to allow pressure to equalize. This mitigates blood splatter from vacuum pressure in the syringe. NOTE: Residual blood can remain on top of septum from the syringe luer tip if equalization does not occur prior to disconnection.



**5. ALWAYS** clean septum with alcohol prep pad prior to each connection.

**NOTE:** Not swabbing to remove excess blood from top of septum can result in blood going in between housing and septum.
